About the School

Established in 1985 as a non-profit, Maa Anandmayee Memorial School (MAMS) is a co-educational K12 High School that makes direct teaching-learning interventions that facilitate learners to grow to their full potential, achieve self-actualization and develop competencies to face today's challenges with élan.

Situated in a pristine village that is often considered sacred, MAMS is perhaps the only senior secondary school operating in the interior locales of a National Park: Rajaji Tiger Reserve. The school overlooks the foothills of picturesque Shivalik Himalayas around the serene Doon valley, and it has efficiently used its locational edge to successfully groom thousands of next-generation leaders over 3 decades of relentless service in the rural education space.

The education at MAMS disrupts mainstream rote learning in its mission to augment the lives of underserved students through holistic schooling. It expedites an unparalleled awakening using a broader 4E paradigm with a vision to Educate, to Enlighten, to Enrich, and to Empower the rural community. The educational journey provided at MAMS goes beyond imparting basic knowledge: through carefully planned, inter-disciplinary scholastic and



co-scholastic programmes, we at MAMS endeavour to equip our learners with necessary life skills and values that help them to face the vagaries of life in a confident & courageous manner. We focus on providing quality experiential learning and behavioural immersion facilitated through workshops, industrial visits, nature walks, and cultural exchanges, all at affordable rates. MAMS employs a design-thinking approach to equip with 21st-century skill-sets that can be used to address real-world issues.

The Pedagogical Approach

This will be an invaluable preparation not only for leadership roles in the future but also for further studies in India or abroad. It will enable students to expand their horizons across multiple academic disciplines, and learn through the lenses of young facilitators they can relate to. This approach will be a departure from rote learning and will provide with a unique, intellectually stimulating and creative approach to understanding what leadership is and how it can be seen and practised in the future.

THE ESSENTIALS:

The Performing Arts

Music and Drama are used to explore creativity and self-expression by giving students opportunities to develop ideas, and script, practise and perform them. In addition to supporting spatial learning and temporal reasoning in young adults, the programme will give students an opportunity to collaborate, influence and lead. Students will have the chance to be taught by experienced teachers and young facilitators who they can relate to.

Communication

The experience offers participants opportunities to understand the impact of (and practise) influential writing, speaking, presentation skills and non-verbal cues (eg: body language). Soft-skills help students to deal with and positively manage diverse environments, dissent, challenging situations and people.

The Outdoor Experience

The programme makes use of Raiwala and Rishikesh's proximity to a rich and diverse natural environment. The outdoor activity provides an appreciation for natural beauty and its forces. This is based on short, age-appropriate activities such as trekking and camping in the outdoors - inspiring planning, endurance, leadership and teamwork, as well as enhancing participants' awareness of the environment and the challenges that we human beings pose to it.

Guest Lectures

A variety of guest lecturers will speak to and interact with participants over the course of the programme. Interactions may be in person or be facilitated remotely through video conferencing. NGO leaders, Business persons, Professionals and innovators from diverse walks of life will provide practical and anecdotal examples of leadership with reference to their experience.

Social Service and Social Responsibility

Students will participate in selected social and community projects that make an impact on the lives of the marginalised and underserved sections of society. At the core of the MAMS curriculum is community service that inspires empathy,

compassion and creates positivity towards action in challenging the status quo amongst young leaders.

Reflection

Central to the course are periods of reflection and contemplation. These enable participants to develop the mindfulness and equilibrium essential to inspirational leadership.

Where are We?

The school is located a short, 30-minute flight North of Delhi and is situated in a safe and secure environment adjoining the Rajaji National Park on the Haridwar - Rishikesh highway (Uttarakhand). Delhi is the nearest international airport. There are several flights from Delhi and direct flights from Mumbai, Bangalore, and Hyderabad. The school can also be reached by train or by road from all over India. The nearest railway station is Raiwala and candidates are advised to take Mussoorie Express in case travelling from Delhi.

Staying at MAMS

This is a residential programme. MAMS offers a safe and welcoming campus experience for young men and women from across India. The cost of accommodation and food is included in the fee. Nestled in the Doon Valley with the magnificent Garhwal Himalayas to the north and the Sal-clothed Shivaliks to the south the school is set in a wooded campus comprising of 15 acres of lush surroundings, which offers an idyllic location for young people to learn.

MAMS has comfortable boarding houses with appropriate facilities. Girls and boys will be in separate houses that will be fully staffed with experienced faculty. Wifi internet access and recreational facilities will be made available. The school dining room and catering staff are adept to provide for healthy, comfortable and tasty meals on campus. We will have a medical practitioner full-time for the entire duration to cater to exigencies. MAMS has a liaison with hospitals, clinics and other medical facilities in and around Raiwala/ Rishikesh.



FAQ

What will be the style of the Programme?

The programme will be a blend of experiential learning, motivational lectures, outdoor activity, sports, and technological immersion. A critically important element will be social service and social responsibility, and their relationship with leadership.

Communication Skills and Performing Arts: Written and verbal communication skills training will include activities such as public speaking that give help improve their linguistic competence.

Experiential Soft Skills Training: Activities such as Model United Nations (MUN) help enhance skills such as critical thinking, positive attitude, conflict resolution, stress management making students emotionally intelligent.

Personalised Counselling and Tests: Personalised counselling sessions for the students in which counsellor will discuss the students' experiences, problems, progress, understanding as well as test-based analysis.

Sports & Adventure: There are dedicated days and hours for a wide array of sports, physical training sessions, leadership and team-building games, and adventure camps.

Technological Immersion: The STEM & Innovation Lab is the cornerstone of MAMS education. The Tinkering Lab set up in collaboration with **MakersBox and facilitated by a Teach for India** alumnus will lead students to learn about contemporary technologies such as Artificial Intelligence, Virtual Reality, Machine Learning, Internet of Things and so on.

Yoga Sessions: Learning Yoga at an early age have lasting and immense benefits on the overall health and well-being of the student. We will have regular practice sessions to help improve posture, increase lung capacity, boost memory, facilitate the development of a positive attitude and to further enhance the discovery of each students' highest potential.



Photography: Photography not only teaches students creative skills and useful skills for the future, but it also could lead to a career in the performing arts, or as a professional artist or photographer. Photography brings students closer to their culture and nature. Photo walks may involve travelling to various places which will help students learn the importance of these places and the culture of the people living in that place.

Community Outreach: Social Service & Social Responsibility programmes help develop leadership through service. Students will be banded together to create positive change through their collaborative work

Guest Lectures: There will be a series of motivational & educational lectures from people of different backgrounds. The modern education system has made guest lectures an important part of their learning and leadership development strategies. Guest speakers are like a blessing for the students, especially when they are addressed by industry personalities

What is the weather like at that time of the year?

Average temperatures range between a low of 17°C (62°F) and 32°C (89°F). Normally, there is little or no rain in the first two weeks of June. Light clothing is recommended and students are advised to carry appropriate sports gear as well.
